6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to congressional and legislative
8 districts; amending 14 O.S. 2001, Section 80, as
9 amended by Section 1, Chapter 53, O.S.L. 2004 (14
10 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 80), which relates to
11 qualifications of certain candidates; clarifying
12 language; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 14 O.S. 2001, Section 80, as
15 amended by Section 1, Chapter 53, O.S.L. 2004 (14 O.S. Supp. 2009,
16 Section 80), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 80. To file as a candidate for the Senate in any
18 senatorial district, a person must have been a registered voter in
19 the district and a resident residing within such district for at
20 least six (6) months immediately preceding the filing period
21 prescribed by law. Except, however, to file as a candidate for the
22 Senate in any senatorial district in 2004, a person must have been a
23 registered voter and a resident residing in such district no later
24 than December 21, 2003. Any member of the Senate whose district has
been changed by a ~~reapportionment~~ redistricting may change residence

1 with the intent of becoming qualified to seek reelection in such
2 district in the first election applicable to such district following
3 the ~~reapportionment~~ redistricting without thereby being deemed to
4 have vacated his or her existing office.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
