6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to economic development; specifying
8 certain duties of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce
9 and certain institution of higher education; stating
10 legislative findings and intent; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3613 of Title 68, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall collaborate with
17 an Oklahoma institution of higher education that offers a gunsmith
18 curriculum to develop strategies to attract a firearms manufacturer
19 to locate in close proximity to such institution.

20 B. Such institution of higher education shall designate a
21 liaison with the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to coordinate said
22 efforts.

23 C. It is the finding of the Oklahoma Legislature that the
24 manufacturing of firearms is a manufacturing activity classified in

1 the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Manual
2 under Industry Sector Number 33, as defined in Section 3603 et seq.
3 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and therefore qualifies for
4 certain economic incentives. It is the intent of the Oklahoma
5 Legislature that the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and other
6 agencies of this state with the responsibility of recruiting or
7 assisting in the recruitment of businesses actively promote the use
8 of existing economic incentives to firearms manufacturers as
9 inducement to relocate to Oklahoma.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
