9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the State Fire
11 Marshal; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
13 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting the salary of the State Fire Marshal;
16 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
20 State Fire Marshal from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
23 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
24 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office
 2 of the State Fire Marshal shall budget all funds in the following
 3 categories and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
 11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 14 upon the Office of the State Fire Marshal by law shall be set by the
 15 State Fire Marshal. The salary of the State Fire Marshal shall not
 16 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
 17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Office of the State Fire
 18 Marshal for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject
 19 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
 20 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
 21 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
 22 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
