9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Indigent Defense  
11 System; requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 providing budgetary limitations; exempting certain  
15 employees from budgetary limitations; and providing  
16 an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
19 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System shall budget all funds in the  
20 following categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System by law shall be set by the  
6 Executive Director of the Oklahoma Indigent Defense System. The  
7 Oklahoma Indigent Defense System for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
8 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
9 full-time-equivalent employees, except those used for the statewide  
10 Trial Indigent Defense System, and expenditures, except as may be  
11 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
12 the Oklahoma Statutes:
