8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
10 Investigation; making an appropriation; stating
purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
11 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
providing for duties and compensation of employees;
12 limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary
limitations; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
17 Bureau of Investigation from any monies not otherwise appropriated
18 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
19 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars
20 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
21 imposed upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
23 Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall budget all funds in the
24 following categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation by law shall be set
13 by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
14 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma State Bureau of
16 Investigation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be
17 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
18 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
19 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
20 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
21 Statutes:
