AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Council on Judicial  
Complaints; making an appropriation; stating purpose;  
requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary  
limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on  
Judicial Complaints from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
Council on Judicial Complaints shall budget all funds in the  
following categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
8 upon the Council on Judicial Complaints by law shall be set by the  
9 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed  
10 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Council on Judicial  
12 Complaints for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be  
13 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
14 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
15 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
16 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
17 Statutes:
