5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
7 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 625, which relates to
8 the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners; clarifying
reference; and providing an effective date.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 625, is
11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 625. Each member of ~~said Board~~ the State Board of
13 Osteopathic Examiners shall, before entering upon the duties of the
14 office, take the oath of office prescribed by the Constitution
15 before someone qualified to administer oaths, and shall, except for
16 the lay person, make oath that the member is a legally qualified
17 practitioner of osteopathic medicine in this state; and that the
18 member has been engaged in the active practice of osteopathic
19 medicine in this state at least five (5) years preceding the
20 appointment of such member.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
