9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Council on Law Enforcement
11 Education and Training; making an appropriation;
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
13 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
14 measures; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law
20 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
23 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
24 the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
Training by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall budget all
3 funds in the following categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law
13 shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not
14 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Council on Law
16 Enforcement Education and Training for the fiscal year ending June
17 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
18 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
19 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
20 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
21 the Oklahoma Statutes:
