6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to labor; amending Section 2, Chapter
8 177, O.S.L. 2003, as renumbered by Section 29,
9 Chapter 176, O.S.L. 2006 (40 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
10 2-404.2), which relates to work of limited duration;
11 clarifying language and punctuation; providing an
12 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 2, Chapter 177, O.S.L.
15 2003, as renumbered by Section 29, Chapter 176, O.S.L. 2006 (40 O.S.
16 Supp. 2009, Section 2-404.2), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 2-404.2. WORK OF A LIMITED DURATION OF TIME.

18 A. When an employer employs a worker for a limited duration of
19 time specified by the employer, the worker is considered to have
20 been laid off due to lack of work at the end of the time period set
21 by the employer; ~~provided, that~~ provided, ~~that~~ the worker's separation was due
22 only to the completion of the work or the expiration of the time
23 period.

24 B. When an employer employs a worker for a limited duration of
time specified by the worker, the worker is considered to have

1 voluntarily quit work at the end of the time period set by the
2 worker; provided, ~~that~~ the worker's separation was due only to the
3 expiration of the time period.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
