8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal
11 Investigations; making an appropriation; stating
12 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
13 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
15 limiting salary of the Chief Medical Examiner;
16 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
17 effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of
22 Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise
23 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by
law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Board
2 of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the
3 following categories and amounts:

7 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by
12 the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not
13 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Board of Medicolegal
15 Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be
16 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
17 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
18 capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as may
19 be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74
20 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
