8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
11 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
performance measures; providing for duties and
14 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
15 Director; providing budgetary limitations; and
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
19 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not
20 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
21 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
22 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be
23 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State
24 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall
3 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

12 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
13 each budget category.

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
17 Control by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the
18 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
19 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.
20 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control
21 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
22 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,
23 except hours coded as overtime wages, and expenditures excluding

1 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
2 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
3 the Oklahoma Statutes:
