9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Pardon and Parole Board;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing  
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
16 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Pardon  
18 and Parole Board shall budget all funds in the following categories  
19 and amounts:

20 <u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
21 Administrative Services	\$0.00	\$0.00

22 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
23 each budget category.

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
3 upon the Office of the Pardon and Parole Board by law shall be set  
4 by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director  
5 shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable  
6 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Office of the  
7 Pardon and Parole Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,  
8 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-  
9 time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures  
10 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized  
11 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
12 Oklahoma Statutes:
