6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.  
8 2001, Section 8-101, which relates to qualifications  
9 for elected officials; adding certain exemption; and  
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 8-101, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 8-101. A municipal elected official shall be a resident  
16 and a registered voter of the municipality in which he or she  
17 serves, except if such person owns a business within the municipal  
18 boundaries and the person is a resident of the county in which the  
19 municipality is located, then such person shall be exempt of the  
20 residency requirements and all councilmembers or trustees from wards  
21 shall be actual residents of their respective wards. If an elected  
22 official ceases to be a resident of the municipality, he or she  
23 shall thereupon cease to be an elected official of that  
24 municipality.
