6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to agriculture; amending 2 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 2-12, which relates to unpaid checks;
9 clarifying language; requiring the Department of
10 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to report
11 uncollectable debts to certain entities; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 2 O.S. 2001, Section 2-12, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2-12. A. For accounting purposes only, when any check
17 has been received by the State Board of Agriculture, or the State
18 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, and has remained
19 unpaid for a period of more than five (5) years, and the Board
20 determines that the check cannot be collected, the amount of the
21 check shall not be included or carried as an asset of the Board or
22 any of its funds.

23 B. If all appropriate collection remedies have been exhausted
24 in the collection of any debt owed to the Department, the debt shall

1 be considered uncollectable. A list of all uncollectable debts and
2 persons who owed the debts, shall be reported to the Oklahoma
3 Legislature, the Office of State Finance, and the Oklahoma Tax
4 Commission no later than May 1st of each calendar year.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
