6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1038, as amended by  
9 Section 10, Chapter 318, O.S.L. 2003 (59 O.S. Supp.  
10 2009, Section 1038), which relates to expiration of  
11 licenses; deleting language; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1038, as  
15 amended by Section 10, Chapter 318, O.S.L. 2003 (59 O.S. Supp. 2009,  
16 Section 1038), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1038. A. ~~Until June 30, 2004, no license shall be~~  
18 ~~issued for longer than one (1) year and all licenses shall expire on~~  
19 ~~June 30 of each year.~~ Beginning July 1, 2004, all licenses shall  
20 expire on the birth date of the licensee. The Construction  
21 Industries Board shall establish by rule a method for prorating  
22 license fees to coincide with the birth date of the licensee.

23 B. An application for the renewal of a license which is  
24 received more than thirty (30) days following the date of expiration  
and which is accompanied by a fee established pursuant to Section

1 1000.5 of this title, and proof of current continuing education  
2 requirements, may be accepted and the license reissued without  
3 examination.

4 C. The fee for late renewal and the continuing education  
5 requirements shall not be required of any holder of a license which  
6 expires while such holder is in military service, if application for  
7 renewal is made within one (1) year following the service discharge  
8 of such person.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
