9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
18 Department of Public Safety shall budget all funds in the following
19 categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the
13 Commissioner. The Department of Public Safety for the fiscal year
14 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
15 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures,
16 except the full-time-equivalent employee limit shall not include
17 cadets while they are members of a patrol school or during their
18 employment in probationary status, excluding expenditures for
19 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
20 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
21 Statutes:
