8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Supreme Court; making an
11 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
12 in certain categories and amounts; providing for
13 duties and compensation of employees of the Supreme
14 Court; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees of the Court of Civil Appeals; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court
20 from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue
21 Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
22 the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as
23 may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Supreme
24 Court and the Court of Civil Appeals by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Supreme Court shall budget all funds in the following categories and
3 amounts:

14 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
15 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
16 upon the Supreme Court by law shall be set by the Supreme Court
17 Justices by majority vote.

18 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
19 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
20 upon the Court of Civil Appeals by law shall be set by the Court of
21 Civil Appeals, subject to the approval of the Supreme Court.

22 SECTION 5. The Supreme Court and the Court of Civil Appeals for
23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
24 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,

1 excluding active retired judges, and expenditures, excluding
2 expenditures for capital and special projects and excluding lawful
3 expenditures from the State Judicial Fund, except as may be
4 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
5 the Oklahoma Statutes:
