9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Workers' Compensation Court;  
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an  
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Workers'  
18 Compensation Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from  
19 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
20 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
21 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
22 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law.

23 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
24 Workers' Compensation Court shall budget all funds in the following  
categories and amounts:

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
7 upon the Workers' Compensation Court by law shall be set by the  
8 Administrator. The Workers' Compensation Court for the fiscal year  
9 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
10 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, excluding active  
11 retired judges, and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital  
12 and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
13 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

17 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective September 1, 2009.
