6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to law enforcement education and
8 training; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 3311.2,
9 which relates to the Council on Law Enforcement
Education and Training; clarifying language; and
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 3311.2, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 3311.2. A. In addition to the other powers and duties
16 imposed by law, the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
17 Training shall have the powers, duties and responsibilities as are
18 specified by the Polygraph Examiners Act. In addition, the Council
19 on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall designate a
20 representative of the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
21 Training to attend any meeting held by the Polygraph Examiners
22 Board. It shall be the duty of the Council on Law Enforcement
23 Education and Training to provide telephone and mailing services for
24 the Polygraph Examiners Board, and such secretarial duties and

1 administrative functions as are designated by the Polygraph
2 Examiners Board which are necessary to effectuate the Polygraph
3 Examiners Act.

4 B. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training is
5 authorized to appoint and fix the duties and compensation pursuant
6 to law of the employees necessary to carry out the duties imposed
7 upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by this
8 section and the Polygraph Examiners Act.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
