6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to professional and occupations;  
8 amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1685.1, as amended by  
9 Section 8, Chapter 457, O.S.L. 2002 (59 O.S. Supp.  
10 2009, Section 1685.1), which relates to temporary  
11 license; modifying language; and providing an  
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1685.1, as  
15 amended by Section 8, Chapter 457, O.S.L. 2002 (59 O.S. Supp. 2009,  
16 Section 1685.1), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1685.1 A. Within one (1) year of the date the Governor  
18 of this state declares a state of emergency in response to a  
19 disaster involving the destruction of dwelling units, the  
20 Construction Industries Board shall issue a distinctively colored,  
21 nonrenewable, temporary journeyman electrician license which shall  
22 expire one (1) year after the date of declaration to any person who  
23 is currently licensed as a journeyman electrician by another state  
24 and who:

1        1. Submits, within ten (10) days of beginning journeyman  
2 electrician's work in this state, an application and fee for a  
3 journeyman electrician's examination;

4        2. Takes and passes the examination at the first opportunity  
5 thereafter offered by the Board; and

6        3. Pays a temporary journeyman electrician's license fee to be  
7 established by rule by the Board pursuant to Section 1000.5 of this  
8 title.

9        B. Nothing in this section shall be construed as ~~prohibiting~~ to  
10 prohibit any person from qualifying at any time for any other  
11 license by meeting the requirements for the other license.

12        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
