7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; providing
9 for enhancement of certain penalties for crimes
10 against certain victims; providing for codification;
11 and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 55 of Title 21, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Every person who, having been convicted of malicious
18 intimidation or harassment on a basis of a person's race, color,
19 religion, ancestry, national origin or disability pursuant to
20 Section 850 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, commits any
21 subsequent crime that results in a filing of an indictment or
22 information pursuant to Section 850 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma,
23 shall be subject to a penalty that is twice what the penalty
24

1 provides for the crime or crimes under which the person is
2 ultimately convicted.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
