9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the State Board of Career and
11 Technology Education; making an appropriation;
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
13 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
14 measures; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees; limiting salary of the Director; providing
16 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
17 date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of
20 Career and Technology Education from any monies not otherwise
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
23 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
24 the duties imposed upon the State Board of Career and Technology
Education by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State
2 Board of Career and Technology Education shall budget all funds in
3 the following categories and amounts:

10 The State Board shall develop outcome-based performance measures
11 for each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education by
15 law shall be set by the Board. The salary of the Director of the
16 Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education shall not
17 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
18 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Department
19 of Career and Technology Education for the fiscal year ending June
20 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
21 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
22 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be

1 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
2 the Oklahoma Statutes:
