9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
11 Emergency Management; making an appropriation;
12 stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain
13 categories and amounts; requiring certain performance
14 measures; providing for duties and compensation of
15 employees; limiting the salary of the Director;
16 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
20 Department of Emergency Management from any monies not otherwise
21 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____
23 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
24 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Emergency
Management by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
2 Department of Civil Emergency Management shall budget all funds in
3 the following categories and amounts:

7 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management by law shall be
12 set by the Director. The salary of the Director of the Oklahoma
13 Department of Emergency Management shall not exceed
14 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Department of
16 Emergency Management for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall
17 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
18 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
19 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
20 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
21 Statutes:
