6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to probate procedure; amending 58  
8 O.S. 2001, Section 23, which relates to requisites of  
petition for probate; making language gender neutral;  
and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 58 O.S. 2001, Section 23, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 23. A petition for the probate of a will must show:

15 1. The jurisdictional facts;

16 2. Whether the person named as executor consents to act, or  
17 renounces his or her right to the letters testamentary;

18 3. The names, ages, and residence of the heirs, legatees, and  
19 devisees of the decedent, so far as known to the petitioner;

20 4. The probable value and character of the property of the  
21 estate;

22 5. The name of the person for whom letters testamentary are  
23 prayed.  
24

1 The petition for the probate of a will must be in writing and  
2 signed by the applicant or his or her counsel.

3 No defect of form, or in the statement of jurisdictional facts  
4 actually existing, shall make void the probate of a will.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
