8 AS INTRODUCED

9  
10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
Commerce; making an appropriation; stating purpose;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
12 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing  
13 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
18 Department of Commerce from any monies not otherwise appropriated  
19 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal  
20 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
21 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
22 imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
2 Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall budget all funds in the  
3 following categories and amounts:

11 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
12 each budget category.

13 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
15 upon the Oklahoma Department of Commerce by law shall be set by the  
16 Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director of the  
17 Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
18 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year  
19 ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce for the  
20 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
21 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
22 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
23 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
24 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
