6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishment; amending 21  
8 O.S. 2001, Section 484, which relates to relatives  
9 who cannot hold office; specifying district judges  
and special judges do not work for the same agency;  
and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 484, is  
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 484. Any person related within the third degree by  
16 affinity or consanguinity to any elected member of the legislative,  
17 judicial or executive branch of the state government shall not be  
18 eligible to hold any clerkship, office, position, employment or duty  
19 for which compensation is received in the same agency as such  
20 elected member of the state government.

21 For purposes of this section, district judges and associate  
22 district judges, in judicial districts with a population exceeding  
23 four hundred thousand (400,000) in the last Federal Decennial  
24 Census, do not work for the same agency as special judges.

1       SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
