6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to children; amending 10 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 1505a, which relates to assistant juvenile  
9 officer in certain counties; making language gender  
neutral; and providing and effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 10 O.S. 2001, Section 1505a, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1505a. In every county of the state having a population  
15 of more than twenty-four thousand (24,000), but less than forty  
16 thousand (40,000), and having located within it a city with a  
17 population of not less than twenty thousand (20,000), according to  
18 the latest Federal Decennial Census, in which county there is  
19 employed a juvenile officer, an assistant juvenile officer may be  
20 appointed by order of the associate district judge with the consent  
21 of the chief judge of the judicial district in which said county is  
22 located. The assistant so appointed may receive as his or her annual  
23 compensation the sum of not more than Six Thousand Dollars  
24 (\$6,000.00), payable monthly; provided, however, no part of said

1 salary or salaries shall be paid out of the court fund, or from  
2 state appropriated funds; and provided further, that such salary may  
3 be set by order of said chief judge upon concurrence of a majority  
4 of the county commissioners of such county.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
