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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement
8 Authority; amending 73 O. S. 2001, Section 163, which
9 relates to powers of the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement
Authority; updating references; and declaring an
emergency.

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2001, Section 163, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 163. In order to prevent any defaults or threatened
16 defaults in the payment of said bonds, the Oklahoma Capitol
17 Improvement Authority is hereby authorized and empowered, in
18 cooperation with the ~~Office of Public Affairs~~ Department of Central
19 Services, to require state departments and agencies to be housed in
20 a building and to pay rent for the use and occupancy of said
21 building. Rents paid by state departments and agencies and all
22 other revenues received by the Authority shall be placed in the
23 Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority Fund for the purpose of
24 maintenance of said buildings and retiring said bonds. When all

1 bonds issued for the construction of any building constructed
2 pursuant to Sections 151 through 214 of this title have been paid in
3 full, the building shall become the property of the State of
4 Oklahoma and shall thereafter be under the full and exclusive
5 supervision of the ~~Office of Public Affairs~~ Department of Central
6 Services.

7 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
