6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
8 2001, Section 1-103, as last amended by Section 2,
9 Chapter 120, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section
10 1-103), which relates to emergency vehicles; modifying
11 list of vehicles which are considered authorized
12 emergency vehicles; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 1-103, as
15 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 120, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp.
16 2008, Section 1-103), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1-103. A. When equipped as prescribed in subsection B
18 of this section:

- 19 1. Vehicles of fire departments;
- 20 2. Ambulances or vehicles specified pursuant to subsection B of
21 Section 1-2512 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes of licensed
22 ambulance service providers;
- 23 3. State vehicles of law enforcement agencies;
- 24 4. County vehicles of sheriffs and full-time commissioned
deputies and vehicles designated by the sheriff for support of the

1 sheriff's office including privately owned vehicles driven by the
2 sheriff and full-time, part-time and reserve commissioned deputies;
3 provided the audible sirens and flashing red lights equipped on such
4 privately owned vehicles are used only in a law enforcement capacity
5 and in the course of duty;

6 5. Municipal vehicles of police departments;

7 6. Vehicles owned and operated by the United States Marshals
8 Service or the Federal Bureau of Investigation;

9 7. Vehicles of Oklahoma National Guard units designated by the
10 Adjutant General for support to civil authorities; or

11 8. Vehicles owned ~~and~~ or operated by any local organization for
12 emergency management as defined by Section 683.3 of Title 63 of the
13 Oklahoma Statutes,
14 are authorized emergency vehicles.

15 B. All vehicles prescribed in subsection A of this section shall
16 be equipped with sirens capable of giving audible signals as required
17 by the provisions of Section 12-218 of this title and flashing red
18 lights as authorized by the provisions of Section 12-218 of this
19 title.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
