SENATE BILL 362

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Office of the Attorney General; making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of the Attorney General by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Attorney General shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

10       SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
12 upon the Office of the Attorney General by law shall be set by the  
13 Attorney General. The Office of the Attorney General for the fiscal  
14 year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
15 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as  
16 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
17 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
