SENATE BILL 363

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Department of Corrections; making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the Director; authorizing employment of certain percentage of employees in the unclassified service; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Corrections from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Corrections by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Department of Corrections shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Department of Corrections by law shall be set by the
12 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
13 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
14 ending June 30, 2010. The Department of Corrections for the fiscal
15 year ending June 30, 2010, shall be authorized to employ up to six
16 percent (6%) of its total authorized full-time-equivalent employees
17 in the unclassified service and shall be subject to the following
18 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
19 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
20 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
21 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
