6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the District Attorneys Council;  
8 making an appropriation to the Office of the Attorney  
9 General for the benefit of the District Attorneys  
10 Council; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in  
11 certain categories and amounts; requiring certain  
12 performance measures; providing for duties and  
13 compensation of employees; providing budgetary  
14 limitations; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
15 Attorney General from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
18 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
19 upon the District Attorneys Council by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
21 District Attorneys Council shall budget all funds in the following  
22 categories and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
14 upon the district attorneys and District Attorneys Council by law  
15 shall be set by the district attorneys and the District Attorneys  
16 Council as provided by Section 215.35C of Title 19 of the Oklahoma  
17 Statutes. The district attorneys and District Attorneys Council for  
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the  
19 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
20 and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
21 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
