6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of
8 Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; making an
9 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
10 in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain
11 performance measures; providing for duties and
12 compensation of employees; limiting salary of the
13 Director; providing budgetary limitations; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State
17 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not
18 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
19 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
20 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be
21 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma State
22 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control by law.

23 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
24 Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control shall
25 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

9 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
10 each budget category.

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
14 Control by law shall be set by the Director. The salary of the
15 Director shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
16 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.
17 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control
18 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
19 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,
20 except hours coded as overtime wages, and expenditures excluding
21 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
22 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
23 the Oklahoma Statutes:
