6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Pardon and Parole Board;  
8 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
9 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
10 requiring certain performance measures; providing for  
11 the duties and compensation of employees; limiting  
12 the salary of the Executive Director; providing  
13 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
14 date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Pardon and  
17 Parole Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
18 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
19 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
20 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
21 upon the Pardon and Parole Board by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Pardon  
23 and Parole Board shall budget all funds in the following categories  
24 and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the Office of the Pardon and Parole Board by law shall be set  
6 by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director  
7 shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable  
8 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Office of the  
9 Pardon and Parole Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,  
10 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-  
11 time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures  
12 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized  
13 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
14 Oklahoma Statutes:
