6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;  
8 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
9 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
10 requiring certain performance measures; providing for  
duties and compensation of employees; providing  
11 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
12 date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
15 Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
18 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
19 upon the Department of Public Safety by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
21 Department of Public Safety shall budget all funds in the following  
22 categories and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
14 upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the  
15 Commissioner. The Department of Public Safety for the fiscal year  
16 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
17 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures,  
18 except the full-time-equivalent employee limit shall not include  
19 cadets while they are members of a patrol school or during their  
20 employment in probationary status, excluding expenditures for  
21 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
22 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
23 Statutes:
