SENATE BILL 375

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Supreme Court; making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; providing for duties and compensation of employees of the Supreme Court; providing for duties and compensation of employees of the Court of Civil Appeals; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Supreme Court and the Court of Civil Appeals by law.

SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Supreme Court shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

9       SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
11 upon the Supreme Court by law shall be set by the Supreme Court  
12 Justices by majority vote.

13       SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
15 upon the Court of Civil Appeals by law shall be set by the Court of  
16 Civil Appeals, subject to the approval of the Supreme Court.

17       SECTION 5. The Supreme Court and the Court of Civil Appeals for  
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the  
19 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,  
20 excluding active retired judges, and expenditures, excluding  
21 expenditures for capital and special projects and excluding lawful  
22 expenditures from the State Judicial Fund, except as may be  
23 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
24 the Oklahoma Statutes:
