6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;
8 authorizing the board of county commissioners to
9 provide enforcement of certain regulations and set
10 certain penalties; authorizing the county sheriff to
11 be responsible for enforcing certain regulations;
12 setting fees and penalties; providing for
13 codification; providing for an effective date; and
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 868.11A of Title 19, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. The board of county commissioners may provide for
20 enforcement of its regulations and establish fines, penalties or
21 imprisonment, for any offense in violation of its regulations, which
22 shall be recoverable together with costs of suit.

23 B. The county sheriff in such counties shall be responsible for
24 the enforcement of subsection A of this section.

1 C. Any person violating the regulations provided for in
2 subsection A of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor which
3 shall be punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding
4 one (1) year or by a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars
5 (\$500.00), or both such fine and imprisonment.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
