6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 2-118, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter
9 83, 2nd Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 2006 (26 O.S.
10 Supp. 2008, Section 2-118), which relates to
11 compensation of county election board secretaries;
12 providing that certain compensation be considered
13 minimum; providing that certain provisions not
14 preclude additional compensation from certain
15 sources; providing an effective date; and declaring
16 an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 2-118, as
19 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 83, 2nd Extraordinary Session,
20 O.S.L. 2006 (26 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 2-118), is amended to read
21 as follows:

22 Section 2-118. A. The secretary of each county election board
23 shall be paid ~~an~~ a minimum annual salary to be determined by the
24 schedule specified in subsection B of this section. However, the
25 salary of a county election board secretary shall not fall below the
26 level of the April 30, 2003, salary, and the salary of any person
27 who is reappointed to the position of county election board

1 secretary shall not fall below the salary received in the
 2 immediately preceding term, regardless of the number of active
 3 registered voters in the county. A county election board secretary
 4 serving on April 30, 2004, shall not receive a salary increase if
 5 ~~said~~ the secretary is paid an amount greater than the salary
 6 indicated in this section according to the number of registered
 7 voters in ~~said~~ the county, except as provided in subsection D of
 8 this section. A county election board secretary shall not receive a
 9 salary increase while the county is under the administrative
 10 supervision of the State Election Board.

9 ~~B-~~ C. The salary and fringe benefits paid to each secretary
10 shall be paid from county funds on a monthly basis and shall be
11 reimbursed from funds appropriated by the Legislature for that
12 purpose at a rate of not to exceed one hundred thirty-five percent
13 (135%) of the above-specified salaries. Claims for ~~said~~ the
14 reimbursement shall be filed according to procedures prescribed by
15 the Secretary of the State Election Board and approved by the
16 Director of State Finance. ~~Said~~ The claims for reimbursement shall
17 only be paid for actual expenditures made by the county. The number
18 of registered voters, for the purposes of this section, shall be
19 determined by the number of registered voters, excluding inactive
20 voters, in the county on January 1, 1979, and every two (2) years
21 thereafter.

22 D. The provisions of this section shall not preclude a county
23 from providing compensation from county funds for the secretary of
24 the county election board in addition to that provided by this

1 section; provided, any such additional compensation shall not be
2 reimbursed from funds appropriated by the Legislature.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
