6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;  
8 prohibiting the state from participating in certain  
9 national road system organizations; prohibiting  
10 certain facilities from locating in this state;  
11 prohibiting connection to certain state highway  
12 system; providing for state law enforcement;  
13 prohibiting certain private or foreign law  
14 enforcement; providing for development, management  
15 and maintenance of certain state highway systems;  
16 providing for codification; and declaring an  
17 emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1700 of Title 69, unless there  
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. Upon the effective date of this act, the State of Oklahoma  
23 or any agency, department, entity or political subdivision thereof  
24 shall be prohibited from participating in, or paying dues or fees  
thereto, the North America's SuperCorridor Coalition, Inc. (NASCO),  
or any successor affiliate or subsidiary thereof or any organization

1 associated with or supporting the creation of an international  
2 highway system in whole or in part.

3 B. The State of Oklahoma shall be prohibited from participating  
4 with any NASCO Trade Corridor Management System (TCMS), and no  
5 facilities, such as NASCO's special project, NAFTRACS (North  
6 American Facilitation, Transportation, Trade, Reduced Congestion and  
7 Security), NASCO "SaviTrak", "Savi Networks" facility or "Savi site"  
8 or any other Radio Frequency Identification (RFID)-based facilities,  
9 shall be established in this state.

10 C. The State of Oklahoma shall prohibit the connection of any  
11 portion of the Trans Texas Corridor (TTC-35) or any successor-named  
12 highway to any road or highway transportation system currently  
13 existing or to be constructed in this state.

14 D. Any state highway or federal highway under the jurisdiction  
15 of this state shall remain under the direct control and jurisdiction  
16 of this state and any agency, department, entity or political  
17 subdivision thereof on behalf of the citizens of this state. All  
18 law enforcement duties associated with any state or federal highway  
19 system under the jurisdiction of this state shall be provided by  
20 public law enforcement agencies as provided by law, and no private  
21 or foreign agencies shall be authorized to perform law enforcement  
22 duties on any state or federal highway in this state.

23 E. The development, management and maintenance of all highway  
24 transportation systems in this state, including but not limited to

1 any current or future toll road systems, shall be done by the State  
2 of Oklahoma on behalf of the citizens of this state and all highway  
3 users in compliance with state law.

4 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
