6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Highway Remediation  
8 and Cleanup Services Act; stating exceptions for  
9 certain railroads and electric utilities; providing  
10 for codification; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-7-406 of Title 27A, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. The provisions of the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and  
16 Cleanup Services Act shall not apply to discharges or spills  
17 occurring during the course of rail transportation at locations  
18 including, but not limited to, highway, street or road intersections  
19 or other locations involving railroad tracks.

20 B. The provisions the Oklahoma Highway Remediation and Cleanup  
21 Services Act shall not apply to discharges or spills from stationary  
22 facilities or transportation of equipment under the control of an  
23 electric utility.

1       SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
