6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; authorizing the
8 Oklahoma Department of Corrections to establish a
9 Career Incentive Bonus Program for certain employees;
10 specifying conditions to qualify for a bonus payment;
11 specifying amount of bonus payment; providing for
12 codification; providing an effective date; and
13 declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.17A of Title 74, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 840-2.17 of Title
19 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Oklahoma Department of Corrections
20 is authorized to establish a Career Incentive Bonus Program for all
21 full-time classified and regular unclassified employees except for
22 correctional teachers and vocational instructors, who have completed
23 at least five years of continuous service and have an overall rating
24 of "meets standards" or "exceeds standards" on a performance
evaluation whose end date falls within the twelve (12) months

1 preceding the career incentive payment. The Career Incentive Bonus
2 Program shall not replace any incentive or pay programs that are
3 authorized by law.

4 B. Career Incentive Bonus Program payments of Two Thousand Five
5 Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be made in July of each year to
6 those Oklahoma Department of Corrections employees who meet the
7 requirements specified in subsection A of this section and who have
8 five or more years of state service as of June 30 of each year.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
