9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Arts Council;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing  
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
16 date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
18 Oklahoma Arts Council shall budget all funds in the following  
19 categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the Oklahoma Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council.  
6 The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
7 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year  
8 ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Arts Council for the fiscal year  
9 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
10 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
11 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
12 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
13 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
