6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
8 2001, Section 63, as amended by Section 7, Chapter  
9 319, O.S.L. 2008 (74 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section 63),  
10 which relates to powers and authority of the  
11 Department of Central Services; authorizing the  
12 Department of Central Services to acquire certain  
13 property under certain circumstances; and providing  
14 an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 63, as  
17 amended by Section 7, Chapter 319, O.S.L. 2008 (74 O.S. Supp. 2008,  
18 Section 63), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 63. A. The Department of Central Services shall have  
20 power to promulgate rules not inconsistent with the laws of this  
21 state.

22 B. The Department of Central Services shall have charge of the  
23 construction, repair, maintenance, insurance, and operation of all  
24 buildings owned, used, or occupied by or on behalf of the state  
including buildings owned by the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement  
Authority where such services are carried out by contract with the

1 Authority, except as otherwise provided by law. Whenever feasible,  
2 the Department of Central Services may utilize the Construction  
3 Division of the Department of Corrections for the construction and  
4 repair of buildings for the Department of Corrections.

5 C. The Director of the Department of Central Services shall  
6 have authority to purchase all material and perform all other duties  
7 necessary in the construction, repair, and maintenance of all  
8 buildings under its management or control, shall make all necessary  
9 contracts by or on behalf of the state for any buildings or rooms  
10 rented for the use of the state or any of the officers thereof, and  
11 shall have charge of the arrangement and allotment of space in such  
12 buildings among the different state officers except as otherwise  
13 provided by law.

14 D. The Department of Central Services shall not have any  
15 authority or responsibility for buildings, rooms or space under the  
16 management or control of the University Hospitals Authority.

17 E. The Department of Central Services shall have the custody  
18 and control of all state property, and all other property managed or  
19 used by the state, except military stores and such property under  
20 the control of the State Banking Department and the two houses of  
21 the State Legislature, and shall procure all necessary insurance  
22 thereon against loss and shall allot the use of the property to the  
23 several offices of the state, and prescribe where the property shall  
24 be kept for public use.

1 F. The Department of Central Services shall keep an accurate  
2 account of all property purchased for the state or any of the  
3 departments or officers thereof, except that purchased for and by  
4 the two houses of the State Legislature. The two houses shall have  
5 the exclusive use, care, and custody of their respective chambers,  
6 committee rooms, furniture, and property, and shall keep their  
7 respective records of said furniture and property.

8 G. The Department of Central Services shall not have any  
9 authority or responsibility for property purchased for or under the  
10 management or control of the University Hospitals Authority except  
11 as expressly provided by law.

12 H. The Department of Central Services shall have the authority  
13 to acquire real property when it is in the best interest of the  
14 state.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
