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6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to energy; requiring the Oklahoma  
8 Comprehensive Energy Plan; stating purpose; requiring  
9 plan by Secretary of Energy; authorizing assistance;  
10 requiring report by certain date; stating  
11 distribution; providing for noncodification; and  
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 The Legislature hereby finds and declares that the State of  
17 Oklahoma should develop a comprehensive energy plan for the purpose  
18 of giving the citizens of this state a guideline for conserving  
19 current energy resources, providing clean and economical energy  
20 sources in the near future and promoting the development of new  
21 energy technologies which will continue our state tradition of being  
22 a leader in energy production for the nation. The Oklahoma  
23 Comprehensive Energy Plan will be drafted following a study directed  
24 by the Secretary of Energy. The Secretary may appoint a group of

1 private citizens and public officials for assistance in drafting the  
2 Oklahoma Comprehensive Energy Plan. The plan shall be finalized by  
3 December 1, 2009 and distributed to the Governor, the President Pro  
4 Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives.

5 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
