6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to geologic storage of carbon  
8 dioxide; re-creating the Oklahoma Geologic Storage of  
9 Carbon Dioxide Task Force; providing for continuation  
10 of members and duties; stating purpose; requiring  
11 report by certain date; stating distribution;  
12 providing for termination; providing for  
13 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
16 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

17 A. The Oklahoma Geologic Storage of Carbon Dioxide Task Force  
18 created pursuant to Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1765 of the 2nd Session  
19 of the 51st Legislature, is hereby re-created to continue until  
20 December 1, 2009. The members previously appointed to the task  
21 force shall continue to serve with new members appointed as  
22 necessary by the original appointing authority pursuant to the  
23 provisions of Senate Bill No. 1765. Staffing and travel  
24 reimbursement provisions shall remain the same as provided in Senate  
Bill No. 1765.

1 B. The task force shall continue to study any issues necessary  
2 to implement the transmission and storage of carbon dioxide in  
3 geologic formations, including, but not limited to, insurance,  
4 liability and ownership issues relating to long-term carbon dioxide  
5 storage facilities and the task force shall make a report which may  
6 include legislative recommendations following the termination of its  
7 activities. Such report shall be distributed to the Governor, the  
8 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
9 Representatives no later than December 15, 2009.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
