8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Commissioners of the Land
10 Office; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;
14 limiting salary of the Secretary and the Assistant
15 Secretary; providing budgetary limitations; and
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commissioners of
19 the Land Office from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
22 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
23 upon the Commissioners of the Land Office by law.

24 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
Commissioners of the Land Office shall budget all funds in the
following categories and amounts:

7 The Department shall develop outcome-based performance measures
8 for each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
11 upon the Department of the Commissioners of the Land Office by law
12 shall be set by the Secretary of the Department. The salary of the
13 Secretary shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
14 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.
15 The salary of the Assistant Secretary shall not exceed ninety
16 percent (90%) of the Secretary's salary per annum, payable monthly
17 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Department of the
18 Commissioners of the Land Office for the fiscal year ending June 30,
19 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
20 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
21 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
22 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
23 the Oklahoma Statutes:
