8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of  
10 Libraries; making an appropriation; stating purpose;  
11 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
12 amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary  
15 limitations; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
18 Department of Libraries from any monies not otherwise appropriated  
19 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal  
20 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
21 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
22 upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law.

23 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
24 Oklahoma Department of Libraries shall budget all funds in the  
25 following categories and amounts:

5 The Department shall develop outcome-based performance measures  
6 for each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
9 upon the Oklahoma Department of Libraries by law shall be set by the  
10 Director of the Oklahoma Department of Libraries. The salary of the  
11 Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
12 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.  
13 The Oklahoma Department of Libraries for the fiscal year ending June  
14 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
15 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding  
16 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
17 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
18 the Oklahoma Statutes:
