6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to solid waste disposal; amending 27A
8 O.S. 2001, Section 2-10-801.1, which relates to
9 vegetation plans; modifying time period for
10 implementation of vegetation plan; and declaring an
11 emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2001, Section 2-10-801.1,
14 is amended to read as follows:

15 Section 2-10-801.1 The owner or operator of any commercial
16 solid waste landfill, over fifty (50) feet in height above natural
17 surface contours that accepts more than two hundred (200) tons per
18 day of solid waste, must submit a vegetation plan to the Department
19 of Environmental Quality for approval. The vegetation plan shall
20 address establishment and maintenance of appropriate vegetative
21 cover for the purposes of erosion and dust control and aesthetic
22 enhancement. The vegetation plan shall be implemented in waste
23 disposal areas that have been undisturbed for ~~ninety (90)~~ one
24 hundred (100) days. The Environmental Quality Board shall

1 promulgate rules, developed and recommended by the Solid Waste
2 Management Advisory Council, relative to the contents of the
3 vegetation plan.

4 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
