8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Board of Private  
10 Vocational Schools; making an appropriation; stating  
purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
11 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
12 limiting salary of the Director; providing budgetary  
limitations; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Board  
17 of Private Vocational Schools from any monies not otherwise  
18 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
20 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
21 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational  
22 Schools by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
2 Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools shall budget all funds  
3 in the following categories and amounts:

7 The Board shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
8 each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
11 upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools by law shall  
12 be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed  
13 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
14 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Board of Private  
15 Vocational Schools, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall  
16 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
17 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
18 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
19 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
20 Statutes:
