5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the Alternative Fueled Vehicle  
7 Advisory Committee; creating committee; stating  
8 membership; stating purpose; providing for travel  
9 reimbursement; providing for reports and  
10 recommendations; providing termination; providing for  
11 noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
14 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

15 A. There is hereby created a State Alternative Fueled Vehicle  
16 Advisory Committee. The membership of such committee shall be as  
17 follows:

18 1. The Secretary of Energy, who shall serve as chair of the  
19 Advisory Committee;

20 2. The Secretary of Environment;

21 3. The Director of the Department of Central Services;

22 4. One member of the Oklahoma State Senate, to be appointed by  
23 the President Pro Tempore;

1           5. One member of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, to be  
2 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and

3           6. Four persons to be appointed by the Governor.

4           B. The purpose of the advisory committee will be to assess the  
5 current fleet of vehicles owned and operated by the state and  
6 determine the benefit of converting or purchasing alternative-fueled  
7 vehicles for the purpose of conserving energy resources, promoting  
8 cleaner fuel technology and reducing the negative impact to our  
9 environment.

10          C. Members of the advisory committee shall receive no  
11 compensation for serving on the advisory committee, but shall  
12 receive travel reimbursement as follows:

13           1. Legislative members of the advisory committee shall be  
14 reimbursed by their respective appointing authorities for necessary  
15 travel expenses incurred in the performance of their duties in  
16 accordance with Section 456 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

17           2. Non-legislative members of the advisory committee shall be  
18 reimbursed by their agencies or appointing authority for their  
19 necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of their  
20 duties in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act; and

21           3. Members of the advisory committee who are not otherwise  
22 officers or employees of the state shall be reimbursed by the Office  
23 of the Governor in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement  
24 Act.

1 D. All members, with the exception of the Legislative members,  
2 shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

3 E. The advisory committee may make any reports or  
4 recommendations it deems necessary and appropriate to the Governor,  
5 the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House  
6 of Representatives.

7 F. The activities of the advisory committee shall terminate no  
8 later than one year following the effective date of this act.

9 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
